Illustrative photos will show what a red line at 1:1250 and 1:2500 actually looks like on the ground. The talk will also discuss the problems of scaffolding and oversailing tower cranes, and what to include in a licence to oversail.

Attendees will be able to understand what a party wall is and the problems faced by surveyors and their developer clients.
